
One year since the commencement of the pandemic.





Hyd at ddoe, roeddem wedi rhoi dros 420,000 o frechlynnau Covid-19 yng ngogledd Cymru, gan ddefnyddio'r brechlyn Pfizer a'r brechlyn AstraZeneca.

Mae hyn yn cynnwys 104,000 o ail ddosau o'r brechlyn.

As of yesterday we had given over 420,000 covid-19 vaccines in north Wales, using both Pfizer vaccine and AstraZeneca vaccine.

This includes 104,000 2nd dose vaccines.



- Cefnogi cynigion i barhau i reoli effaith y pandemig ar Wasanaethau Iechyd Meddwl Plant a Phobl Ifanc (CAMHS) ac i sicrhau yr ymdrinnir â'r goblygiadau tymor hwy i'r blynnyddoedd cynnar, plant a phobl ifanc
- Rhoi'r gorau i ddefnyddio capaciti cleifion mewnol yn Ysbyty Enfys Glannau Dyfrdwy o 26 Mawrth ar ôl rhyddhau'r cleifion presennol
- Cefnogi cynigion i ddatblygu ymhellach gefnogaeth y Bwrdd Iechyd ar gyfer anghenion yn codi o Covid hir

- Approval of SOPs for the Covid-19 vaccination programme
- Approval for use of additional facilities to support inpatients at Ysbyty Gwynedd
- Support for proposals to continue to manage the impact of the pandemic on Child Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) and to ensure the longer term implications for early years, children and young people are addressed
- Pausing use of inpatient capacity at Ysbyty Enfys Deeside from 26 March after discharge of the current inpatients
- Support for proposals to develop further the Health Board's support for needs arising from long Covid



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
