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Pwy ydym ni

- Rydym ni'n gyfrifol am ddarparu gwasanaethau gofal iechyd i fwy na 700,000 o bobl ledled chwe sir Gogledd Cymru. Mae hyn yn cynnwys iechyd sylfaenol a chymunedol, ac iechyd meddwl yn ogystal â gwasanaethau ysbytai aciwt.
- Rydym yn gweithredu tri phrif ysbyty ac 17 ysbyty cymunedol, ynghyd â rhwydwaith o ganolfannau iechyd, clinigau, unedau iechyd meddwl a chanolfannau timau cymunedol. Rydym hefyd yn darparu gwasanaethau gofal iechyd carchar i CEF Berwyn, Wrecsam.
- Mae'r Bwrdd Iechyd yn cydlynu gwaith 96 o bractisau meddygon teulu, yn ogystal â gwasanaethau'r GIG sy'n cael eu darparu gan 83 o bractisau deintyddol ac orthodontig, 69 o bractisau optometreg ac optegwyr a 147 o fferyllfeydd yng Ngogledd Cymru.
- Rydym ni hefyd yn gyfrifol, trwy bartneriaeth, am wella iechyd a lles pobl leol drwy weithgareddau megis ein rhaglenni brechu llwyddiannus a gwasanaethau iechyd ar gyfer ysgolion.



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Who we are

- We are responsible for the delivery of health care services to more than 700,000 people across the six counties of North Wales. This includes primary, community and mental health as well as acute hospital services.
- We operate three main hospitals and 17 community hospitals, along with a network of health centres, clinics, mental health units and community team bases, and also deliver prison health care services within HMP Berwyn, Wrexham.
- The Health Board coordinates the work of 96 GP practices, and NHS services provided by 83 dental and orthodontic practices, 69 optometry practices and opticians and 144 pharmacies in North Wales.
- We are also responsible, in partnership, for improving the health and wellbeing of local people through activities such as our successful vaccination programmes and school health services.



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2025/26 – Heriau

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2025/26 – Challenges

This has been a year of great change for the organisation. It has been a year where we have continued to see improvement, but still face significant challenges, such as:

- Reducing the number of patients waiting a long time for treatment
- Improving access to urgent and emergency care
- Investment in buildings and technology
- Managing finances
- Long term sustainability of services



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2025/26 – Llwyddiannau

Er gwaethaf yr heriau, rydym ni'n gwybod bod ein staff yn mynd ati bob dydd i wneud pethau gwych i gynorthwyo cymunedau ledled Gogledd Cymru a chynorthwyo'i gilydd. Mae rhai o uchafbwyntiau'r flwyddyn yn cynnwys:

- Gostyngiad o 63 y cant yn nifer y cleifion sy'n aros mwy na dwy flynedd am driniaeth (o 5,819 i 2,161). a dileu pob amser aros o fwy na 208 wythnos. Lleihaodd nifer y bobl a oedd yn aros mwy na dwy flynedd am eu hapwyntiad cleifion allanol cyntaf o 49,600 (Gorffennaf 2025) i 2,340 (Mehefin 2026).
- Gostyngodd nifer y bobl a oedd yn aros yn hirach na blwyddyn am eu hapwyntiad cleifion allanol cyntaf o tua 32,000 (Awst 2025), i tua 5,000 (Mehefin 2026) ochr yn ochr â pherfformiad diagnostig sy'n sylweddol well. At ei gilydd, mae'r gwelliant hwn yn golygu bod cleifion yn cael eu gweld ac yn cael y gofal sydd ei angen arnynt yn gyflymach.



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2025/26 – Successes

Despite the challenges, we know that every day our staff do amazing things to support our communities across North Wales and each other. Some of the highlights of the year include:

- A 63 per cent reduction in patients waiting more than two years for treatment and elimination of all waits of more than 208 weeks (from 5,819 to 2,161). The number of people waiting more than two years for their first outpatient appointment was reduced from 49,600 (July 2025) to 2,340 (June 2026).
- The number of people waiting longer than a year for their first outpatient appointment reduced from about 32,000 (August 2025), down to about 5,000 (June 2026) alongside a significantly improved diagnostic performance. Altogether this improvement means patients are being seen and getting the care they need more quickly.



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2025/26 – Llwyddiannau

- Lansio Rhaglen Meistr mewn Fferylliaeth newydd yn Ysgol Feddygol Gogledd Cymru, a ddatblygwyd mewn partneriaeth â Phrifysgol Bangor. Mae'n garreg filltir bwysig arall i Ysgol Feddygol Gogledd Cymru.
- Parhau i fuddsoddi a chryfhau gwasanaethau ar draws ein cymunedau, fel gwasanaethau fferylliaeth, deintyddiaeth ac optometreg.
- Cryfhau a ffurfioli cynllunio strategol yn sylweddol, a fydd yn cyflawni strategaeth 10 mlynedd a Strategaeth Gwasanaethau Clinigol i wella iechyd a lles poblogaeth Gogledd Cymru.
- Cryhau trefniadau llywodraethiant, rheoli risg a rheoli ansawdd.

2025/26 – Successes

- The launch of a new Master of Pharmacy Programme at the North Wales Medical School, which has been developed in partnership with Bangor University and is another major milestone for the North Wales Medical School.
- Continued investment and strengthening of services across our communities, such as pharmacy, dentistry and optometry services.
- Significantly strengthened and formalised strategic planning arrangements, which will deliver a 10-year strategy and Clinical Services Strategy to improve the health and wellbeing of the population of North Wales.
- Strengthened governance, risk management and quality management arrangements.



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2025/26 – Llwyddiannau

- Parhau i fuddsoddi mewn cyfleusterau newydd gyda Chanolfan Lawfeddygol Gogledd Cymru yn Ysbyty Llandudno yn agosáu at ei chwblhau a chynlluniau'n cael eu cyhoeddi ar gyfer ailddatblygu Ysbyty Brenhinol Alexandra yn y Rhyl.
- Trawsnewid digidol gyda chyflwyno system ragnodi electronig newydd a systemau digidol newydd ar gyfer cofnodion cleifion.



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2025/26 – Successes

- Continued investment in new facilities with the North Wales Surgical Hub at Llandudno Hospital moving closer to completion and plans being announced for the redevelopment of the Royal Alexandra Hospital in Rhyl.
- Digital transformation with the rollout of a new electronic prescribing system and new digital patient record systems.



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Y camau nesaf

Gan edrych ymlaen at 2026/27, mae ein ffocws ar adeiladu ar y gwaith cychwynnol a'r gwaith cyflawni cynnar a wnaed hyd yma, a chyflymu'r broses o gyflawni newid i'r gwasanaethau'r rheng flaen gan barhau i greu sefydliad cynaliadwy yn y tymor hir. Mae rhai darnau o waith hollbwysig a fydd yn hanfodol i gyflawni hyn yn cynnwys:

- Gwellu mynediad at wasanaethau, lleihau'r amser y mae pobl yn aros am driniaeth boed wedi'i chynllunio neu mewn argyfwng.
- Gwellu diogelwch cleifion a lleihau niwed y gellir ei osgoi.
- Cryfhau sefydlogrwydd y gweithlu a'r gallu i arwain.

Next steps

Looking ahead to 2026/27, our focus is on building upon the foundational and early delivery work to date and to accelerate delivery of change to front line services, whilst continuing to build a sustainable organisation for the long-term. There are some critical pieces of work that will be fundamental to achieving this, which include:

- Improving access to services, reducing the time people wait for treatment whether planned or in an emergency.
- Improving patient safety and reducing avoidable harm.
- Strengthening workforce stability and leadership capacity.

During 2025/26 the overall focus has been on strengthening quality, safety, governance and organisational learning. Progress has been made whilst the Health Board is still operating in Special Measures

Timely patient access to safe and effective care

Headline areas of improvement:

- Significant reduction in long waits for care
- Improved access to mental health care for adults and children
- Delivering the requirements of the Maternity and Neonatal Quality statement and opening a Women's Health Hub
- Enhancing digital capability
- Improvements in quality governance
- Listening to patients, staff and communities to shape future services

 - Teledermosgopi i helpu i frysennu a chyflymu mynediad bobl sydd â chyflyrau croen
 - Nyrsys arbenigol yn brysennu'n syth i brofion yn gwella mynediad i'r sawl sydd â chanser y coluddyn tebygol
 - Defnyddio endosgopi sbwng llai ymwithiol pan fo'n briodol

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Significant reduction in waits for care

- Reduction in wait for planned care
- Transformation of pathways for urgent suspected cancer
 - Teledermoscopy to help triage and speed up access for those with skin conditions
 - Specialist nurses triaging straight to test improving access for those with suspected bowel cancer
 - Use of less invasive sponge endoscopy when appropriate
 - Nurses trained in prostate biopsy to speed up diagnosis of cancer
 - Two new radiotherapy machines at North Wales Cancer Centre
 - Maggie's Centre opened on Glan Clwyd site

- Gostyngiad sylweddol yn nifer y cleifion a leolir mewn gwelyau 'y tu allan i'r ardal'

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Mental Health improvements

- Improving assessment and treatment times for adult and child mental health services; hitting national targets by March 2026
- Completed a large programme of work to ensure implementation of Royal College of Psychiatry Review working closely with Expert Advisory Group to ensure actions meaningful to service users
- Significant reduction in placement of patients in beds 'out of area'
- Chosen to run pan-Wales gambling support service

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Areas where further work required

- Recognise that our Emergency Departments are overcrowded and wait to be seen and admitted can be long
- Recognise that people can remain in our hospitals for prolonged periods when they are ready to go home
- Programme of work in place across the urgent care pathway and with local authority partners to support more timely discharge
- Support from external partners in place

Improvements in quality governance

- Significant improvement in timeliness of response to complaints and incidents
- Significant improvements in timeliness of mortality reviews
- Integration of response to incidents, complaints, medical examiner concerns and requests from HM Coroner
- Quality Management System introduced; helps service identify areas to improve and structure this improvement. Under refinement following user feedback
- Working on consistent learning both locally and across the Health Board
- Working on reducing occurrence of Never Events

Patient experience and engagement

- Between 1st April 2025 and 31st March 2026, we received a total of 74,285 Civica Patient Experience Surveys. 85.71% of people rated their overall experience as positive (selecting always or usually) .
- Developed for patients in Mental Health services
- All local areas receive and act on this feedback
- Analysis of qualitative feedback undertaken and fed back to services in addition to being reported to Board
- Youth Voice Board established

- Continue to improve performance in urgent suspected cancer pathways to ensure speedy reassurance for those without cancer and prompt treatment for those where a diagnosis is confirmed
- Focus on 'Community by Design' programme to expand care for patients closer to home, away from main hospital sites by supporting primary and community care
- Ensure effective learning from incidents and complaints to improve quality of care
- Ensure we embed the patient / service user voice in improving our care

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Performance against Statutory & Other Financial Targets

Statutory

1. The first financial duty is to ensure that expenditure does not exceed the aggregate funding over a three-year period.
2. The second financial duty is to prepare an Integrated Medium-Term Plan for the following 3 years period.

Other financial targets

1. Pay 95% of all non-NHS invoices within 30 days of receipt of goods or invoice
2. Closing cash balance to be within tolerance limit
3. Capital expenditure remains below allocation by no more than £0.5m

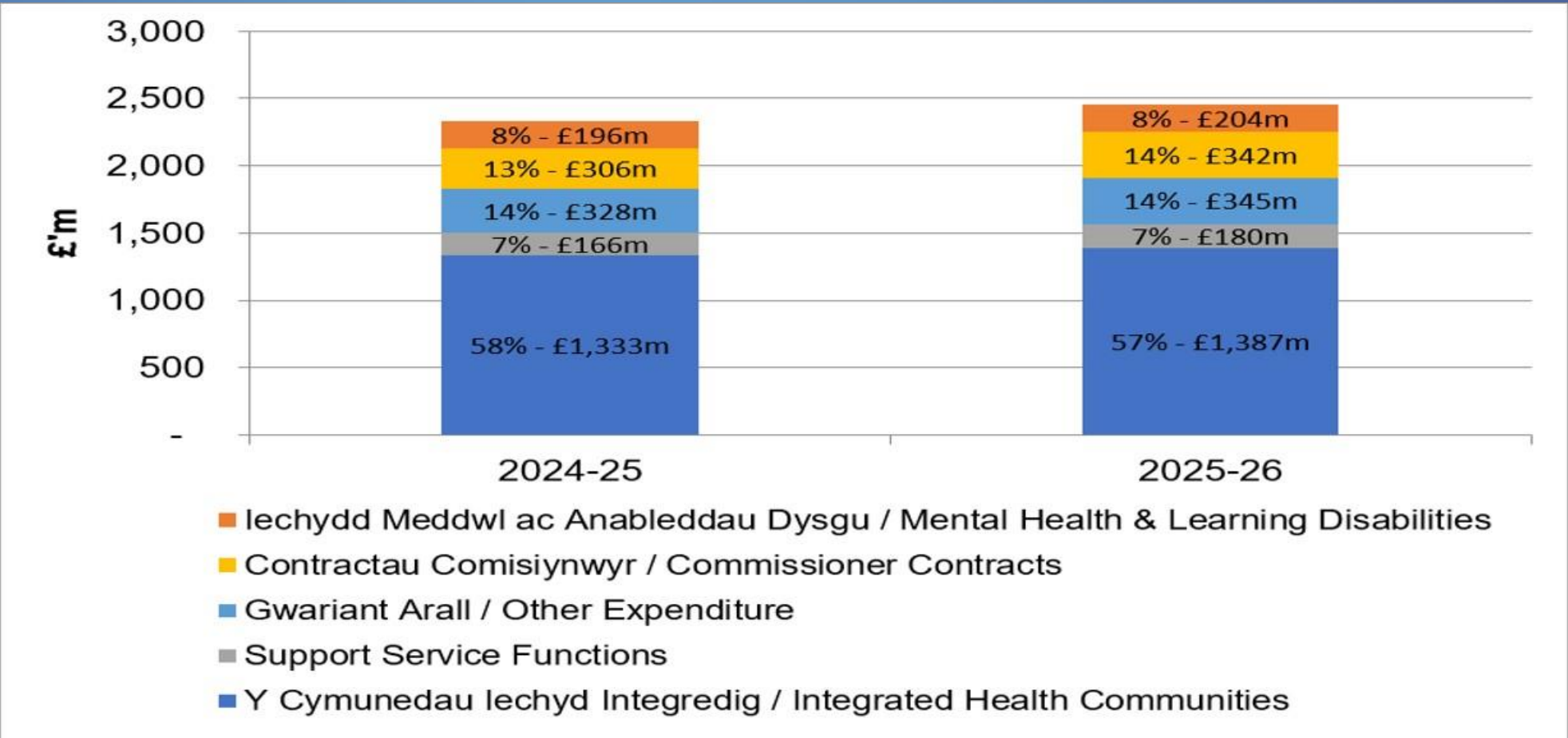

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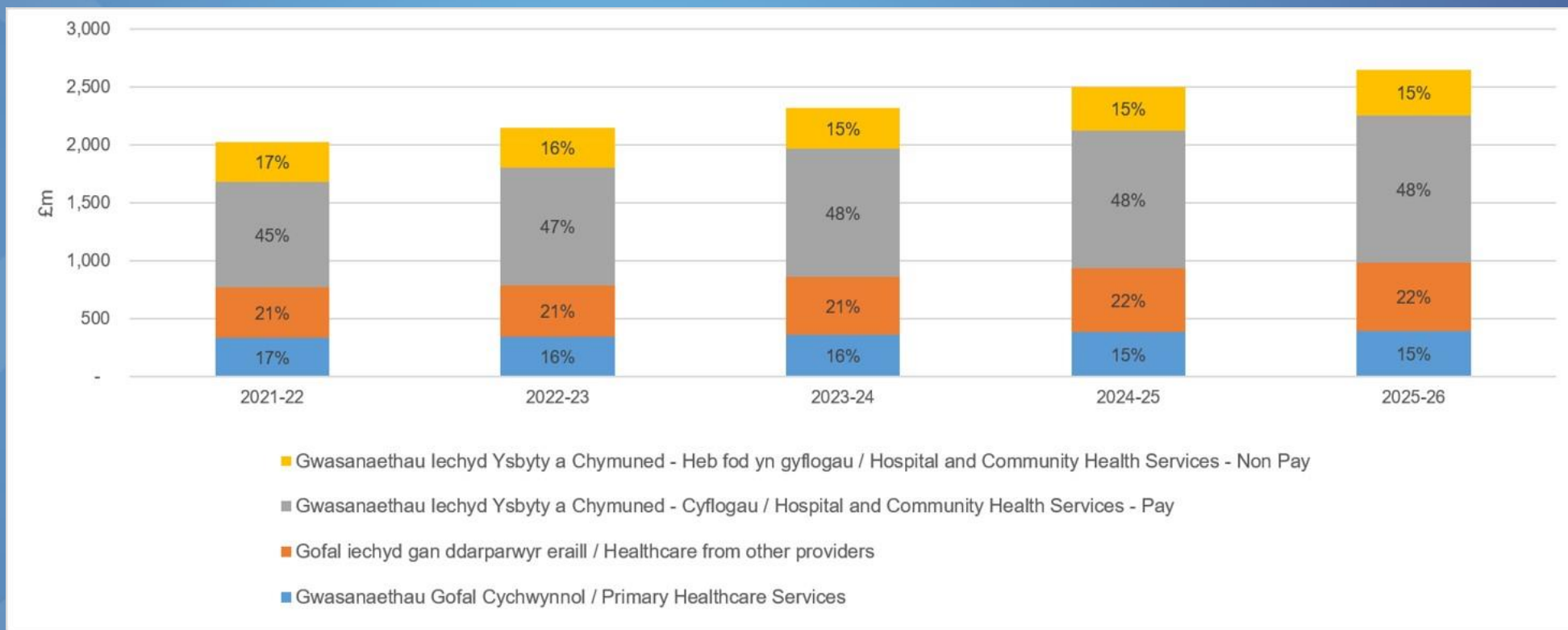

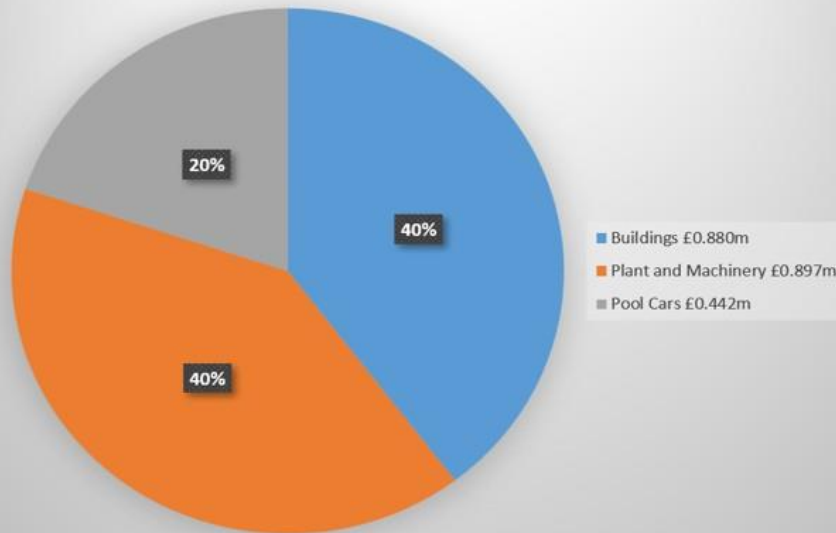

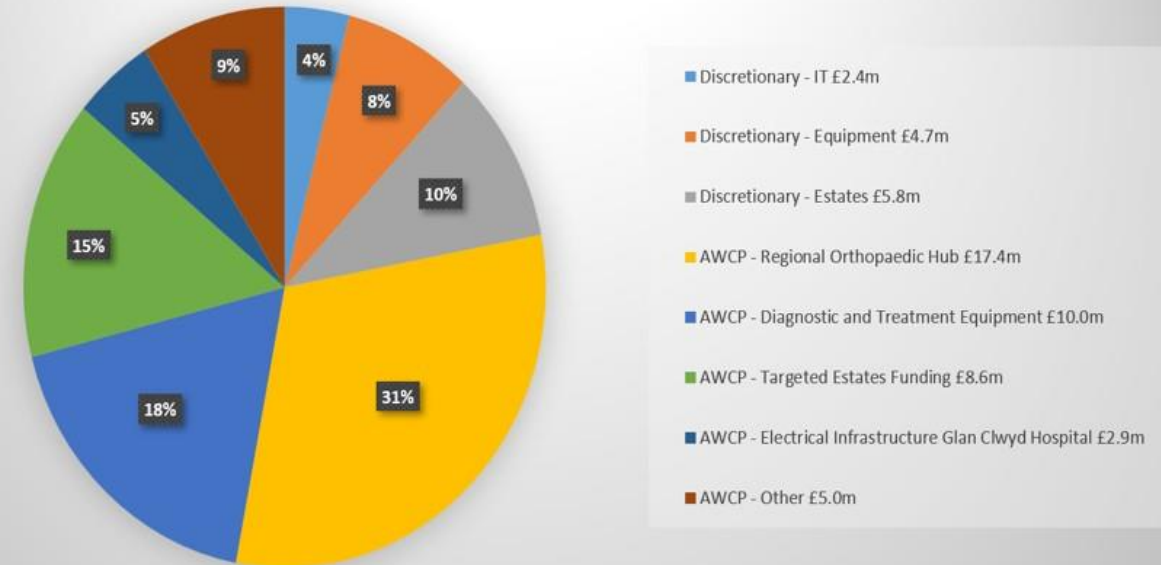

- There is a high level of expectation around delivery and disappointment in relation to perceived delays. BCUHB's reputation is under pressure from politicians and the media
- The challenge from WG has been to deliver a more affordable proposal which still achieves the majority of the benefits
- An Option Appraisal was submitted in April 2024 which demonstrated a reduced scope that could achieve benefits. This was estimated at a capital cost of £60m
