How can SilverCloud help?

- A **FREE** online (computer) course that's easy to use;
- Offering help for a range of different topics;
- Helping you develop skills to manage your mental wellbeing;
- Available to all North Wales residents, aged 16+;
- Use it on any device - phone, tablet, etc.;
- Where and when convenient for you, at your own pace;
- Dip in and out as much or as little as you need;
- Takes approximately 12 weeks;
- Fortnightly review by your own online SilverCloud Supporter;
- Helpful videos and tools for relaxation and mindfulness;
- Materials available for 12 months from sign up;
- All information you enter is confidential.



How does it work?

1. Sign up to SilverCloud, creating a username and password and providing your email address so that we can contact you.
2. Add your personal details and complete a quiz so we understand how you are feeling.
3. When your SilverCloud Supporter reviews your answers, we may need to check with you that this course is the most beneficial for you.
4. Off you go with lots of tools, videos and exercises
5. Every 2 weeks your SilverCloud Supporter will check how you are getting on, write you a review and send a link to the review.
6. Check the review for helpful tips and advice and complete the quiz again so that we can see how you are feeling now compared to when you started.
7. If your SilverCloud Supporter is concerned about your well being, appropriate action will be taken to make sure that you are safe.
8. When 6 reviews (12 weeks) have been completed (or you stop doing the course), your SilverCloud Supporter will let you know that we are no longer monitoring your progress.
9. You will still be able to use the course material for up to 12 months – you can go back and look at all the things you learnt about during your course.

How do I sign up?

STEP 1 – Who is your GP?

Go to the “Choose Your GP” box and click on the small  arrow on the right hand side, pick your GP from the list.

STEP 2 – Which course is best for you?



Click on a course and read the description, if its not the one for you click ↩ (top left) and pick another one. Happy with the one selected? Tick the box and Click on **Apply**.

STEP 3 – Sign Up

Choose a Username and Password, confirm your Password and enter your email address. (*Username cannot contain any spaces*). Click on Sign Up

SilverCloud will send you an email to verify your email address – click on the link. *If you don't receive the email, please check your junk/spam folders.*

STEP 4 – Your Agreement

Read through the Client Contract, click in the box to show that you understand and are happy with the agreement.

STEP 5 – Quiz

Enter your personal details and answer some questions to help us understand how you are feeling.

STEP 6 – Off you go

You are now ready to find out about all the interesting activities in SilverCloud. Work through the modules, read, watch, listen. Have a go with the tools – write a journal, set some goals.

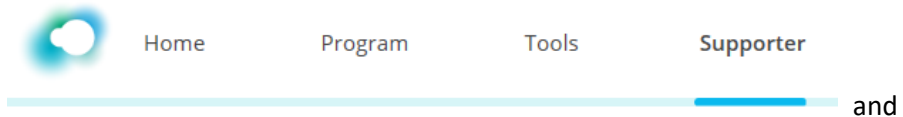
