

North Denbighshire Community Hospital



Notice has been given that Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board is intending to apply for planning permission for a new community hospital at the Royal Alexandra hospital site, Marine Drive, Rhyl.

The new hospital, which will be built next to the existing Royal Alexandra Hospital, will include modern, fit for purpose facilities for new and existing services at the site. New services include:

- Inpatient beds
- Services for treating minor injuries and ailments
- An intravenous therapies suite
- A community well-being hub & community café

The planning application will be submitted in early summer, with the view to commence on site in early 2021.

Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board are presenting the scheme as an opportunity for Rhyl residents to offer feedback on the development prior to the planning submission and would encourage you to get involved in sharing your thoughts and opinions on the project.
