



Thumb loop Splint

This splint is designed to give support to the thumb joint, to help the child when using their hands in fine motor activities such as handwriting, colouring, using cutlery and dressing/ fastening buttons.



How to put the splint on correctly



When removing the Thumb loop splint there will be pressure marks around the wrist and thumb area. The pressure marks should disappear after about 20 minutes. If the pressure marks do not disappear after 20 minutes the splint may have been secured around the wrist too tightly.

Check the Thumb Inhibition Splint regularly for tears and fraying. Washing instructions are attached to the splint.
